Noted the comments received during the statutory consultation for the proposed amendments to the access arrangements to the St. Anselm's Road 'Stop & Shop' parking area and proposed amendments to the parking and traffic arrangements in Blyth Road and Coldharbour Lane, Hayes;2. Approved the relocation of the existing emergency access gate in St. Anselm's Road from the junction of Station Road to the junction of Nield Road, as shown on Appendix A;3. Approved the proposed amendments to the parking arrangements in Blyth Road, Hayes as shown in Appendix B; and4.
