The Cabinet Member for Finance and the Cabinet Member for Environment, Housing and Regeneration have made the following decision today:

<p>1.</p>	<p><i>THE CABINET MEMBER FOR FINANCE AND THE CABINET MEMBER FOR ENVIRONMENT, HOUSING AND REGENERATION</i></p> <p>CHRYSLIS PROGRAMME 2020/21 – CAPITAL RELEASE 6</p> <p>DECISION: <u>FULL APPROVAL</u></p> <p>That the Cabinet Member for Environment, Housing and Regeneration:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. approves the allocation of £134k Chrysalis funding for the refurbishment of the practice cricket nets facility at Hillingdon Manor Cricket Club, Coney Green and the supply and installation of a new modular building unit at the Station Road Allotments site as part of the asset enhancement programme for 2020/21. <p>That the Cabinet Member for Environment, Housing and Regeneration and the Cabinet Member for Finance:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. agree to the capital release request of £134k from the Chrysalis 2020/21 budget to fund the refurbishment of the practice cricket nets facility at Hillingdon Manor Cricket Club, Coney Green and the supply and installation of a new modular building unit at the Station Road Allotments site as part of the asset enhancement programme for 2020/21. <p>REASONS FOR THE DECISIONS MADE</p> <p>The refurbishment of the practice cricket nets facility at Hillingdon Manor Cricket Club, Coney Green was nominated by a local resident in August 2019 on behalf of the Community Association. The concern being that, unless the deterioration of the nets and ground conditions is addressed, the future of Hillingdon Manor Cricket Club could be compromised.</p> <p>The new practice net facility would benefit a wide range of residents including children and young people wanting to learn and participate in the sport, as well as adult members who regularly use the club facilities. This includes newer members of the community who have moved into neighbouring St Andrews Park.</p> <p>The new modular unit will provide the Station Road Allotment holders</p>	<p><i>Perry Scott, Director of Infrastructure, Procurement, Business Improvement, Communications, Waste Services and ICT</i></p> <p><i>Helena Webster, Residents Services</i></p>
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	<p>with a modern, more spacious and DDA accessible building providing a new resource and greater security to replace the original, existing tea hut. The proposal originated from the Chairman of the Station Road Allotment Society Association on behalf of the Allotment members.</p> <p>ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED AND REJECTED</p> <p>The Cabinet Members could decide not to accept all or one of the recommendations. If the release of capital funds is not approved, the Chrysalis 2020/21 programme cannot be effectively and efficiently progressed as planned and the contribution towards putting our residents first cannot be fully realised.</p> <p>FURTHER INFORMATION</p> <p>The detailed report relating to this decision is available to view here.</p>
