The Cabinet Member for Public Safety and Transport has made the following decision today:

1. CABINET MEMBER FOR PUBLIC SAFETY ANDTRANSPORT

OBJECTIONS TO THE PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS ON GLENCOE ROAD AND AIRDREE CLOSE, HAYES

DECISION:

That the Cabinet Member for Public Safety and Transport:

- 1) Noted the objections received during the statutory consultation for the proposed 'At Any Time' waiting restrictions on Glencoe Road and Airdrie Close, Hayes; and
- 2) Approved the introduction of 'At Any Time' waiting restrictions on Glencoe Road but deferred the implementation of restrictions on Airdrie Close at the present time and to keep the situation under review.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION MADE

To improve forward visibility when exiting Airdrie Close onto Glencoe Road yet still maintain parking for residents where possible.
