The Cabinet Member for Public Safety and Transport has made the following decision today:

1. CABINET MEMBER FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND TRANSPORT

DAWLEY PARADE & DALLEGA CLOSE, HAYES - RESULTS OF INFORMAL CONSULTATION FOR A POSSIBLE PARKING MANAGEMENT SCHEME & STOP & SHOP PARKING SCHEME

DECISION:

That the Cabinet Member for Public Safety and Transportation:

- 1. notes the responses received to the informal consultation for a possible introduction of a parking management scheme and Stop & Shop parking scheme in Dawley Parade and Dallega Close, Hayes; and
- 2. approves for statutory consultation to be carried out on a detailed design as shown on Appendix B for a proposed parking management scheme and Stop & Shop parking scheme in Dawley Parade and Dallega Close, Hayes with operating times of 'Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm'.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION MADE

The decision reflects the majority of responses received to the consultation with residents and businesses. The recommendations also reflect the views of the local Ward Councillors.

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED AND REJECTED

The consultation with residents and businesses offered either the option of being included in a proposed parking management scheme and Stop & Shop parking scheme or for no changes to be made to the current parking arrangements.
