The Cabinet Member for Public Safety and Transport has made the following decision today:

1. THE CABINET MEMBER FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND TRANSPORT

INFORMAL CONSULTATION ON EXTENDING EASTCOTE ZONE 'E3' PMS INTO BEECH AVENUE AND OAK GROVE

DECISION:

That the Cabinet Member for Public Safety and Transport:

- 1. Noted the responses received to the informal consultation undertaken in Beech Avenue and Oak Grove regarding the extension of the Eastcote Resident Parking Scheme;
- 2. Instructed officers to formally consult on a Resident Parking Scheme operating Mon-Fri 11am-midday in Beech Avenue and Oak Grove; and
- 3. Subject to the above, approved the implementation of the proposals should the results of the above consultation be positive.
