<p>1.</p>	<p><i>THE CABINET MEMBER FOR FINANCE, THE CABINET MEMBER FOR ENVIRONMENT, HOUSING & REGENERATION AND THE CABINET MEMBER FOR PUBLIC SAFETY & TRANSPORT</i></p> <p><i>CAPITAL RELEASE REPORT (MARCH 2021)</i> <i>DEPARTMENT: RESIDENTS SERVICES</i> <i>SERVICE AREA / PROGRAMME: HIGHWAYS STRUCTURAL WORKS 2020/21 - TOWN CENTRE AND SHOPPING PARADE INITIATIVES 2020/21 - KINGSHILL AVENUE SHOPPING PARADE</i> <i>RELEASE NO: 6</i></p> <p>DECISION: <u>FULL APPROVAL</u></p> <p>That the Cabinet Members for Environment, Housing & Regeneration and Public Safety & Transport, along with the Cabinet Member for Finance, agreed to the capital release request of £322k from the Highways Structural Works 2020/21 Programme budget towards the Town Centres and Shopping Parade Initiatives 2020/21 Programme budget to fund the highways public realm improvements within Kingshill Avenue Shopping Parade.</p> <p>REASONS FOR THE DECISIONS MADE</p> <p>The decision made will upgrade the overall look and feel of Kingshill Avenue Shopping Parade, complementing the shop front grant improvements already underway and ‘future proofing’ this valued local retail, hospitality, and community resource.</p> <p>ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED AND REJECTED</p> <p>The Cabinet Members could have decided not to accept the recommendations.
