That the Cabinet Member for Finance, the Cabinet Member for Families, Education and Wellbeing and the Cabinet Member for Property and Infrastructure agreed to the capital release request of £85k from the Leisure Centre Refurbishment Programme 2020/21 capital budget for the required refurbishment works at Hillingdon Sports and Leisure Complex (see Appendix A of the report).

REASONS FOR THE DECISION MADE

The Council could choose not to complete the work, but this would result in a loss of income and damage to the Council's reputation.

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED AND REJECTED

Essential Repairs Grants are awarded under discretionary powers; hence the alternative option was to not approve the grants.
