Cabinet Members making the decision	Councillor Ian Edwards – Leader of the Council Councillor Martin Goddard – Cabinet Member for Finance
DECISION	That the Leader of the Council and Cabinet Member for Finance: 1) Agreed the allocation of £109,250 (£54,625 per annum over two years) from the s106 contribution relating to the construction of a new hotel at Heathrow Airport (held at case ref PPR/136/409B) towards the Economic Development & Regeneration Team Core Budget to support the coordination of construction training work placements in the Borough; and 2) Agreed the allocation of £64,600 (£32,300 per annum for a period of two years) towards the LBH construction apprenticeship Scheme.
Reason for decision	The allocation of Section 106 (S106) and Section 278 (S278) funds is required to be formally approved by the Leader of the Council and the Cabinet Member for Finance on a case-by-case basis. The report requested the approval for the S106 funds held at the case reference detailed in the report to be committed as outlined in the report.

Alternative options considered and rejected	The Cabinet Members could have agreed to not fund the scheme and / or suggest alternative projects to which funds could be allocated within the terms of the relevant legal agreements. If the S106 funds are not allocated to an appropriate scheme, the unspent funds may need to be refunded.
