BOURNE AVENUE, HAYES - OBJECTION TO PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS

DECISION:

That the Cabinet Member:

- 1. Considered the objections received from the statutory consultation for the proposed 'At Any Time' waiting restrictions on Bourne Avenue, Hayes; and
- 2. Approved the introduction of 'At Any Time' waiting restrictions on Bourne Avenue but keeping the wider parking provision in this area under review.

REASONS FOR THE DECISIONS MADE

To improve access in and out of this end of Bourne Avenue yet still maintain parking for residents where possible.

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED AND REJECTED

The Council could decide not to proceed with the installation of the At Any Time waiting restrictions as advertised.
