HILLINGDON SCHOOL TERM DATES AMENDMENT 2021/22

DECISION:

That the Cabinet Member for Families, Education and Wellbeing approved the amended school term dates for the academic year of 2021/22 due to the additional Bank Holiday provided on Friday 3rd June 2022, noting that this has been amended by reducing the number of teaching days from 190 to 189 (plus 5 inset days), totalling to 194 school days.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION MADE

This decision was required to comply with Department of Education's guidance to ensure that school staff receive the same public bank holiday benefits.
