DECISION	<p>That the Cabinet Member for Public Safety & Transport:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Noted the comments received during the statutory consultation for the proposed introduction of waiting restrictions and a Parking Management Scheme in the vicinity of Woodstock Drive, Ickenham as shown on Appendix A;2) Approved the installation of limited time waiting restrictions on Windrush Close, Witney Close and Woodstock Drive, Ickenham as proposed with operational times of '8.30am to 10.30am and 3.30pm to 4.30pm, Monday to Friday' as shown on Appendix C;3) Approved the installation of Zone 'IC5' Parking Management Scheme in Burford Close and Applewood Close, Ickenham as proposed with operational times of '8.30am to 10.30am and 3.30pm to 4.30pm, Monday to Friday' as shown on Appendix C;4) Agreed to defer the proposed Parking Management Scheme in Heythrop Drive, Ickenham due to the

	overall lack of support demonstrated by residents during consultation.
