Cabinet Members making the decision	Councillor Martin Goddard - Cabinet Member for Finance Councillor Jonathan Bianco - Cabinet Member for Property and Infrastructure
DECISION	That the Cabinet Member for Finance and the Cabinet Member for Property and Infrastructure agreed to the retrospective capital release request of £33k from the 2021/22 School Conditions Building Programme budget for the funding of the emergency gas main works at Harlyn Primary School and associated costs.
Reason for decision	Due to a gas leak at the school, remedial works were required to bring all three boiler rooms back online to provide the school with sufficient heating and hot water.
Alternative options considered and rejected	Further investigatory works were considered to pinpoint the gas leak, but the associated costs were deemed to potentially be higher than installing a new gas main to boiler house 3. Not carrying out the works would have left the school without heating to approximately 1/3 of its classrooms. This would have caused disruption to the school activities.
