DECISION	APPROVED That the Leader of the Council and Cabinet Member for Property and Infrastructure agree with the rent negotiated by officers as detailed in this report and instructs Property and Estates to complete the appropriate rent review memorandum.
Reason for decision	The Cabinet Members are being asked to agree the proposed rent in accordance with the Council's Constitution. This requires the Leader of the Council and Cabinet Member for Property and Infrastructure to formally agree to any rent review.
Alternative options considered and rejected	The Cabinet Members could choose not to approve the rent review negotiated. This is likely to then require the rent review to be referred for third party determination, either by arbitration or expert. This action will involve a degree of risk as third-party determination may result in a rental being determined above or below the rent negotiated between the parties.
