	Automatic Gates, Bollards, Shutters & Barriers, are subject to periodic, thorough examination and inspection; as required by the Machinery Directive Automatic Gates, Bollards, Shutters & Barriers provided for use are thoroughly examined by a competent person at regular intervals.
Alternative options considered and rejected	The Council could decide not to complete regular inspections of its current lift assets. However, it would be in breach of its requirements under Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 and by the Machinery Directive.
