DECISION	APPROVED That the Cabinet Member authorises the renewal of the business lease for 1 & 7 Park Parade, Hayes, negotiated by officers as detailed in the report, and instructs Legal Services to complete the appropriate lease documentation.
Reason for decision	Under the Constitution where the term of the proposed new lease is between 7 and 25 years and the annual rent is any value up to £250,000, the grant of the new lease must be approved by the Cabinet Member for Property and Infrastructure.
Alternative options considered and rejected	Both parties have the option to apply to Court if terms cannot be agreed for the new lease.
