### Decision made

<b>Cabinet Members making the decision</b>	Councillor John Riley - Cabinet Member for Public Safety and Transport Councillor Martin Goddard - Cabinet Member for Finance
<b>DECISION</b>	<b>APPROVED</b>  That the Cabinet Member for Public Safety & Transport and Cabinet Member for Finance:  1) accept the tender for one off Purchase and contract award of six (6) highways fleet vehicles at the cost of £239,338 to the following suppliers:  a. Lot one – 4 Fleet vehicles at the cost of £171,980 from Isuzu Track UK Limited b. Lot two - 2 Fleet vehicles at the cost of £67,358 from Renault UK Limited  2) approve the capital release request of £239,338 from the 2021/22 Purchase of Vehicles capital budget to fund the purchase of six (6) highways vehicles (Appendix A).
<b>Reason for decision</b>	Purchasing of the vehicles will be more cost effective when compared to the alternative option of hiring of the vehicles.

	Purchasing the vehicles is essential to meet a number of separate legislative requirements, including the Government's Environment Bill 2020.
<b>Alternative options considered and rejected</b>	<p>1) The Council could decide to use hired vehicles; however, this is a more expensive option than purchasing and owning our own vehicles.</p> <p>2) The Council could decide to continue to use the existing vehicles but the costs for maintenance and Low Emission Zone fees would be greater than purchasing new vehicles.</p> <p>3) The Council could decide to outsource the service, but this is not a viable solution.</p>
