<b>DECISION</b>	<b>APPROVED</b>  That the Cabinet Member for Finance and the Cabinet Member for Property and Infrastructure agree to the capital release request of £20k from the Housing Revenue Account Works to Stock Programme 2021/22 Fire Safety Workstream capital budget for the Replacement of refuse chute extensions at various housing sites.
<b>Reason for decision</b>	The recommendation is to replace the refuse chutes extensions at various housing owned sites to meet BS1449-1 and this requires automatic shut off plates to be installed within the buildings. The Council is required to carry out these recommendations to be compliant with current regulations.
