<b>DECISION</b>	<b>APPROVED</b>  That the Cabinet Member for Finance and the Cabinet Member for Property and Infrastructure agreed to the capital release request of £83k from the general capital contingency budget for the funding of the Bessingby, Pine Gardens and Field End Parks, Ruislip Flood Risk Alleviation and Management works.
<b>Reason for decision</b>	Flooding within this area has become too common and without intervention local residents will continue to experience flooding in their homes and park users will not have regular access the park. Resolving this issue will ensure residents can continue to live safely and park users can use the facilities.
<b>Alternative options considered and rejected</b>	Not to progress with the works, this would lead to a recurrence of the issue of flooding which occurs every year resulting in on-going residents' claims against the Council.
