DECISION	<p>APPROVED</p> <p>That the Cabinet Member for Public Safety and Transport:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. noted the petition objecting to the proposed motorcycle bay outside Nos. 310 to 312 Kingshill Avenue received during the statutory consultation;2. noted the separate representation concerning the proposed motorcycle bay outside Nos. 310 to 312 Kingshill Avenue received during the statutory consultation;3. approved the installation of the motorcycle bay outside Nos. 310 to 312 Kingshill Avenue as indicated on Appendix A; and4. asked officers to review the situation with the motorcycle parking bay after a period of six to twelve months and report back to the Cabinet Member.
