| DECISION | APPROVED That the Cabinet Member for Finance, Cabinet Member for the Environment, Housing & Regeneration, Cabinet Member for Property & Infrastructure and the Cabinet Member for Families, Education & Wellbeing approved the release of funds of £179k from the Environmental and Recreational Initiatives 2021/22 capital budget to carry out the phase 4 construction works associated with pollution screening works at 15 schools across the Borough (Appendix A). |
| Reasons for decision | The proposed anti-pollution measures at schools related to the Schools Environmental Audit aim to reduce exposure of air pollution levels at schools to children for proven health benefits. |
