<b>Cabinet Members making the decision</b>	Councillor John Riley – Cabinet Member for Public Safety & Transport
<b>DECISION</b>	<b>APPROVED</b>  That the Cabinet Member for Public Safety and Transport:  1. noted the responses received to the informal consultation for a possible introduction of a ‘Stop and Shop’ parking scheme on Kingshill Avenue, Hayes; and  2. approved for statutory consultation to be carried out on a proposed ‘Stop and Shop’ parking scheme in Kingshill Avenue, Hayes with operating times of ‘Monday to Saturday 8am to 6:30pm’.
<b>Reason for decision</b>	The recommendations reflected the views of local Ward Councillors to prohibit long term parking in front of local shops and business premises at Kingshill Parade.
<b>Alternative options considered and rejected</b>	The Council consulted with the directly affected business occupiers and residents on whether they would like a “Stop & Shop” scheme at Kingshill Parade or if they would prefer to retain the current parking arrangements.
