	APPROVED That the Cabinet Member for Finance and the Cabinet Member for Property and Infrastructure agreed to the capital release request of £21k from the Property Works Programme capital budget 2021/22 for the installation of LED communal and emergency lighting to Barra Hall Children's Centre.
Reason for decision	The installation of LED communal and emergency lighting will provide users with adequate means of escape in the event of a mains failure or emergency, should the property need to be evacuated. The Council are required to carry out these recommendations to be compliant with current regulations. The building does not currently have suitable emergency lighting installed. Following the replacement, every light fitting within the building will be replaced to emergency lighting across all rooms.
