#### **Reasons for Recommendation**

The Warrender Primary School Governing Body would like to change their membership of governors, reducing the number of parent governors to 2 and increasing the number of co-opted governors to 7. This will reflect the needs of the school, as it will allow a wider skillset to be present on the governing body. The total number of governors remains at 12.

The number of co-opted governors who are eligible to be elected or appointed as staff governors must not, when counted with the one staff governor and the headteacher, exceed one-third of the total membership of the governing body.
