	APPROVED That the Cabinet Member for Finance and Cabinet Member for Property and Infrastructure agreed to the capital release request of £51k from the School Conditions Building Programme 2021/22 budget for the consultation works and associated costs relating to roofing works at Coteford Infant School and Frithwood Primary School.
Reason for decision	Roof age related defects, on-going leaks and condition surveys have highlighted immediate issues that needed to be addressed at both schools, roofs are considered beyond their serviceable lives and temporary repairs were no longer deemed effective.
Alternative options considered and rejected	Alternatives considered included extensive localised repairs, however the extent of damage to insulation and steelwork meant major works were required.
