	That the Cabinet Member for Finance and Cabinet Member for Property and Infrastructure agreed to the capital release request of £15k from the School Conditions Building Programme 2021/22 budget for the consultation works at Whiteheath Junior School Additional Roofing (Appendix A of the report linked below).
Reason for decision	Due to an existing consultant and contractor on-site carrying out similar works, it was deemed more economic and practical to consider undertaking the works as a contract variation to the existing contracts.
Alternative options considered and rejected	Alternatives considered were less extensive repairs however, due to the complete removal of tiles being required on these options, the associated costs meant a full replacement of the roof was the most economical way to ensure the leaks are resolved.
