	<b>Approved</b>  That the Cabinet Member for Environment, Housing & Regeneration and the Cabinet Member for Finance approved the release of funds of £105k from the Environmental and Recreational Initiatives 2021/22 capital budget to carry out the phase 6 construction works associated with pollution screening works at 13 roadside play areas across the Borough.
Reason for decision	The proposed anti-pollution measures within public spaces relate to the Environmental Audit aim to reduce exposure of air pollution levels to children across the Borough for proven health benefits. A number of roadside play areas were targeted and works would positively impact the health of children using them.
