	<p><b>Approved</b></p> <p><b>That the Cabinet Member for Public Safety and Transport:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) <b>Noted the responses received during the formal consultation undertaken in the Northwood Hills area regarding an extension to the existing Parking Management Scheme;</b></li><li>2) <b>Instructed officers to implement the scheme as proposed with the following changes:</b><ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) <b>Retain the ‘School Keep Clear’ restrictions in Harlyn Drive.</b></li><li>b) <b>Formally consult on ‘at any time’ restrictions in Dale Close as indicated in Appendix D.</b></li></ol></li><li>3) <b>Noted the responses received during the informal consultation undertaken in Highland Road regarding changing the scheme to a ‘Past this Point’ scheme;</b></li><li>4) <b>Prior to implementation of the ‘signs and lines’ scheme in Highland Road, instructed officers to formally consult with residents on amended proposals for Highland Road to a ‘Past this Point’</b></li></ol>
