	Approved That the Cabinet Member for Finance and the Cabinet Member for Property and Infrastructure agreed to the capital release re-allocation requests of £45k from the 2021/22 Property Works Programme capital budget to provide grant funding for repairs to the Grade II* Listed Tudor Churchyard wall at St Martin's Church, West Drayton.
Reason for decision	The Grade II* Listed Tudor walls at St Martin's Church in West Drayton were in poor condition and required repairs to restore the historic wall and protect residents using the church buildings.
Alternative options considered and rejected	The listed wall was confirmed as a health and safety risk to the public due to structurally unsafe condition of the walls. It was recommended that works proceed to protect the public accessing the church.
