	Approved That the Cabinet Member for Finance and the Cabinet Member for Property, Highways and Transport agreed to the following capital release requests of £27k from the Property of Works Programme 2022/23: Contingency Works Programme for the Upgrade of the Ventilation System at Ruislip Bowls Club Main Hall (Appendix A).
Reason for decision	Adding a Mechanical Ventilation with Heat Recovery System (MVHR) will extend the use of the building from its original designed purpose, enabling the building to be used for other activities by the Bowls Club subject to their lease agreement.
Alternative options considered and rejected	Alternative options were explored in line with HSE recommendations – enhanced purge ventilation, short duration occupancy, leaving doors slightly open with users wearing additional clothing. These options were deemed not suitable for the end users of Ruislip Bowls Club.
