Cabinet Members making the decision	Councillor Ian Edwards - Leader of the Council Councillor Jonathan Bianco – Cabinet Member for Property, Highways and Transport
	<b>Approved</b>  <b>That the Leader of the Council and the Cabinet Member for Property, Highways and Transport approved the new domestic vehicle footway crossover policy document set out in Appendix A of the report.</b>
<b>Reason for decision</b>	<p>The introduction of the current crossover policy in 2019 has resulted in a better and more consistent way of dealing with difficult applications, complaints, and appeals. However, to make the application and administration of the policy by officers more effective and practical, a few changes to address some recent challenges and complaints should be considered.</p> <p>This revised policy will also allow more properties to qualify for a crossover, which will also support the growing demand for residents looking to be able to consider electric vehicles and being able to charge these on their own property.</p>
