	Approved That the Cabinet Member for Finance, Cabinet Member for Property, Highways & Transport and Cabinet Member for Residents' Services agree to the capital release request of £101k from the 2022/23 Flood Alleviation – Bessingby Park budget for the funding of flood mitigation works at Bessingby, Pine Gardens and Field End Parks, Ruislip (Appendix A).
Reason for decision	Flooding within the area of these three parks has become too common and without intervention residents will continue to experience flooding in their homes and park users will not have regular access to the parks. Resolving this issue will ensure residents can continue to live safely and park users can use the facilities.
Alternative options considered and rejected	Not to progress with the works, this would lead to a recurrence of the issue of flooding which occurs every year resulting in on-going residents' claims against the Council.
