	<b>Approved</b>  That the Cabinet Member for Finance and Cabinet Member for Children, Families & Education agree to the following capital release request of £728,157 from the Schools SRP/SEND capital programme budget. This is in respect of funding of costs to the Elliot Foundation for internal adaptations to accommodate pupils from the Eden Trust schools; Grangewood School and Moorcroft School.
<b>Reason for decision</b>	To ensure that we have provision in places for 40 pupils that will be on roll at Grangewood and Moorcroft in September 2022. This Capital Release requests the release of funds for these adaptations.
<b>Alternative options considered and rejected</b>	These works were required to ensure that the Council can deliver on one of the projects proposed as part of the deficit recovery plan.
