	<b>Approved</b>  That the Cabinet Member for Children, Families and Education approved the next set of school term dates to be published for the academic years of 2024/25, 2025/26, 2026/27.
Reason for decision	The decision will ensure that maintained schools are open to teach pupils for 190 days and are required to set an additional 5 inset (teacher training) days per academic year within the framework provided, totalling to 195 school days.
