	<ol> <li>That the Cabinet Member for Residents' Services approved the allocation of £66K Chrysalis funding for a new project for improvements at Hillingdon Abbots Rugby Football Club as detailed within the body of the report, as part of the asset enhancement programme for 2022/23.</li> <li>That the Cabinet Member for Residents' Services and the Cabinet Member for Finance agreed to the capital release request of £66K from the 2022/23 Chrysalis Programme to fund improvements at Hillingdon Abbots Rugby Football Club.</li> </ol>
Reason for decision	Hillingdon Council is striving to be the greenest London Borough, to protect and enhance the environment, and to provide a brighter prospect for future generations. Chrysalis, the Council's asset enhancement initiative, funds projects ranging in scale from £5,000 to £100,000 for local initiatives that matter to residents.  Residents are encouraged to make suggestions for Chrysalis funding as the most effective way for local people to identify environmental and community safety projects and

	demonstrating how all residents can play an active part in decisions, making them proud to live in Hillingdon.  The resolutions will enable works to commence on the new project for improvements at Hillingdon Abbots Rugby Football Club, where contractor schedule of rates have been used.
Alternative options considered and rejected	The Cabinet Members could have decided not to accept the recommendations and so the proposed improvements at Hillingdon Abbots Rugby Football Club would not be completed or the community benefits achieved as requested by residents and Ward Councillors.
	If the release of capital funds had not been approved, the Chrysalis 2022/23 programme could not be effectively and efficiently progressed as planned and the Chrysalis contribution towards the Council commitment to be carbon neutral by 2030 could not be fully realised.
