	Approved That the Cabinet Member for Finance and Cabinet Member for Children, Families and Education agreed to the following capital release request of £116,066 from the 2022/23 Schools SRP/SEND capital programme budget for the pre-construction phase of the work to establish a new Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) unit at Wood End Park Academy.
Reason for decision	To ensure the continuation of the work to create a new ASD unit for 24 pupils at Wood End Park Academy. This capital release requests the release of funds for the pre-construction phase of the scheme.
Alternative options considered and rejected	The local authority agreed to provide funding for a scheme to create a 24 place ASD unit at Wood End Park Academy and the delivery of project will be managed by The Park Federation Academy Trust. The project is linked to the DSG Safety Valve Programme.
