	<b>Approved</b>  <b>That the Cabinet Member for Finance, and the Leader of the Council, on behalf of the Cabinet Member for Property, Highways &amp; Transport, agreed to the capital release request of £341k from the West Drayton Crossrail Complimentary Measures programme capital budget for the funding of essential carriageway works within Station Approach serving West Drayton Station.</b>
<b>Reason for decision</b>	Cabinet, on 15 December 2022, agreed that the Council could enter into a funding agreement with Network Rail of up to £397,359 to undertake essential carriageway reconstruction on land owned by Network Rail in Station Approach, West Drayton and authorise the Corporate Director of Place to sign any necessary documentation.  The formal 'Funding from Network Rail' agreement and 'Basic Asset Protection Agreement' had now been signed by the Corporate Director of Place to facilitate works to reconstruct the carriageway in Station Approach, West Drayton scheduled from early June to late July 2023.
