	<b>Approved</b>  That the Cabinet Member for Residents' Services and the Cabinet Member for Finance agreed to the following capital release request of £100,577 from the Botwell Green Sports & Leisure Centre Football Pitch Replacement 2023/24 capital budget to carry out the 3G astroturf pitch works. <b>Reason for decision</b>	Completing this work will ensure that Botwell Green Sports & Leisure Centre continues to operate efficiently and will ensure no loss of income is incurred.
