Councillor Martin Goddard – Cabinet Member for Finance Councillor Eddie Lavery – Cabinet Member for Residents' Services
Approved That the Cabinet Member for Finance and the Cabinet Member for Residents' Services approved the capital release request of £56k budget comprising £49k Rewild London Fund grant and £7k revenue contribution for habitat restoration at The Grove.
The project aim is to enhance the existing features at The Grove and to hence preserve and increase the populations of flora and fauna within the existing habitats - in addition to further developing the reserve as a good example of urban nature conservation.
At present the existing trees around the ponds in The Grove are closed and overgrown, casting heavy shade over the ponds with no aquatic vegetation. Also, dead and/or decaying leaves increase the nutritional value of the water in the pond, triggering an abundance of duckweed. Reduction of the canopy of mature trees and removal of smaller sycamore and holly trees will allow more light to penetrate the pond and marginal vegetation to establish. Following the pond restoration, appropriate planting of wetland species (undertaken by volunteers) will provide a home for invertebrates and amphibians and improve the overall biodiversity of the site.
