<b>Cabinet Members making the decision</b>	Councillor Martin Goddard – Cabinet Member for Finance
	<b>Approved</b>  That the Cabinet Member for Finance approved the allocation and release of £170,230 from the S106 contribution held by the Council at EO/001/554D, to be used towards upgrading the lighting system at Cedars Car Park (£161,338) & Blyth Road Car Park (£8,892) to LED Communal lighting which will improve energy efficiency and reduce carbon emissions.
<b>Reason for decision</b>	The decision will allow the S106 funds to offset the use of the Council's own capital budgets on the Cedars Car Park and Blyth Road Car Park lighting system upgrade projects.
<b>Alternative options considered and rejected</b>	The Cabinet Member could have agreed to fund the scheme and/or suggested alternative projects to which funds could be allocated within the terms of the relevant legal agreements.
