### Decision made

<b>Cabinet Members making the decision</b>	Councillor Jonathan Bianco – Cabinet Member for Property, Highways and Transport Councillor Martin Goddard – Cabinet Member for Finance
	<b>Approved</b>  That the Cabinet Member for Property, Highways & Transport and the Cabinet Member for Finance agreed to the capital release request of £44,000 from the Purchase of Vehicles capital budget for the purchase of a machine package deal provided by Roadmender Asphalt which includes a trailer mounted mastic boiler with tool heater and tools and two KM2-18X infrared heaters for the delivery of highways reactive maintenance work undertaken by the Highways Department's in-house crew.
<b>Reason for decision</b>	The Council's existing Rhino Patch vehicle which was used for reactive highways repair had come to the end of its usable life and parts for the vehicle were no longer manufactured. Officers conducted extensive market research and testing to progress the purchase of a new alternative machine for the delivery of highways reactive maintenance work undertaken by Highways in-house crew while also complying with the Highways Act by repairing the identified defects within the deadline.
<b>Alternative options considered and rejected</b>	To continue reactive maintenance work with the one Rhino Patch machine that had limited capacity and contained parts that, should they require replacement, were now obsolete.
