Noted the objection received during the statutory consultation for the proposed removal of a section of the permit holder parking place outside No. 8 Nursery Way, Uxbridge; and  2. Approved that the section of the parking place outside No. 8 Nursery Way, Uxbridge be removed and replaced with a section of 'Monday to Friday 8am to 5pm' waiting restrictions as proposed and indicated on Appendix A of the associated report.
