<b>Cabinet Members making the decision</b>	Councillor Eddie Lavery – Cabinet Member for Residents' Services Councillor Martin Goddard – Cabinet Member for Finance
<b>Decision</b>	<b>Approved</b>  <b>1) That the Cabinet Member for Resident Services approved the allocation of £95K Chrysalis funding for security fencing improvements at Northwood Football Club as detailed within the body of the report, as part of the asset enhancement programme for 2023/24; and,</b>  <b>2) That the Cabinet Member for Resident Services and the Cabinet Member for Finance agreed to the capital release request of £95k from the 2023/24 Chrysalis Programme budget to fund the security fencing improvements at Northwood Football Club as detailed within the body of the report.</b>
<b>Reason for decision</b>	Chrysalis, the Council's asset enhancement initiative, funds projects ranging in scale from £5,000 to £100,000 for local initiatives that matter to residents.  The decision will enable works to commence on security fencing improvements at Northwood Football Club, including installation

	of goal barriers, where the fencing contractor schedule of rates have been sourced by the Capital Projects team.
<b>Alternative options considered and rejected</b>	The Cabinet Members could have decided not to approve the recommendations, and the security fencing improvements planned at Northwood Football Club would not have gone ahead as planned and the benefits would not have been realised.
