Cabinet Members making the decision	Councillor Jonathan Bianco – Cabinet Member for Property, Highways and Transport Councillor Martin Goddard - Cabinet Member for Finance
Decision	Approved That the Cabinet Member for Property, Highways & Transport and the Cabinet Member for Finance agreed to the capital release request of £5,999,451 for resurfacing No 25 carriageways, No 22 footways and short sections of the Hillingdon's Highway network to be funded from the Highways Structural Works 2023/24 capital budget.
Reason for decision	The decision made enables the release of resources in order to progress the Highways programme for carriageway schemes recommended as detailed in the report (link below). This decision will limit the deterioration of the fabric of the Borough's highways asset that may have resulted in serious failure of roads, footways, verges, highway drainage and street furniture and improve the serviceability of the highway network (for example the visual appearance, the ride quality and structural integrity of the roads and pavements).
Alternative options considered and rejected	There were no alternatives considered due to the level of deterioration as delaying these schemes would have placed additional pressure on the Council's financial resources if permanent repairs were not implemented in a timely manner.
