### Decision made

<b>Cabinet Members making the decision</b>	Councillor Jonathan Bianco – Cabinet Member for Property, Highways and Transport
<b>Decision</b>	<p><b>Approved</b></p> <p>That the Cabinet Member for Property, Highways and Transport:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Noted the responses received to the informal consultation on possible parking controls in Cedars Drive, Uxbridge;</li><li>2) Instructed officers to arrange for statutory consultation to be carried out on a detailed scheme design with residents in Cedars Drive, between its junction with Vine Lane and Buckingham Grove, for a proposed extension to the Hillingdon Hill Parking Management Scheme Zone HN1, based on the responses received to the formal consultation and discussions with local Ward Councillors;</li><li>3) Instructed officers to investigate possible double yellow lines in Attle Close, Bishops Close and Mills Close; and</li><li>4) Instructed officers to take no further action in roads where the majority of residents indicated they would prefer no changes to be made to the current parking arrangements.</li></ol>
<b>Reason for decision</b>	The recommendations reflect the responses received to the informal consultation with residents included in the plan

	attached as Appendix A of the associated report, and discussions with local Ward Councillors.
<b>Alternative options considered and rejected</b>	The consultation with residents offered the options of a single yellow line outside Nos. 1-43 Cedars Drive, or an extension to the Hillingdon Hill Parking Management Scheme, or for no changes to be made to the current parking arrangements.
