Decision	That the Cabinet Member for Property, Highways and Transport, and the Cabinet Member for Finance agreed to the capital release request of £223k from the 2023/24 School Conditions Building Programme budget for the consultation works and associated costs relating to roofing works at 5 schools: Newnham Infant School, Bourne Primary School, Whitehall Infant School, Whiteheath Infant School and Hayes Park School (Appendix A).				
Reason for decision	Roof age-related defects, ongoing leaks and condition surveys have highlighted immediate varying issues at each school. Roofs across the school are considered beyond their serviceable lives and temporary repairs are no longer effective, deeming extensive works required throughout. Energy losses through the current roof fall outside of building regulations; these can be addressed by the works and the improvements to insulation present a payback period through energy savings.				

	The appointment of a consultant is now required to generate a detailed schedule of works to propose the best solution for the defects associated with schools' roofs.
Alternative options considered and rejected	Short term repairs would only delay the issues surrounding the roofs but with poor insulation and high energy losses it would be more beneficial to replace / refurbish the roofs in question.
