Decision	Approved
	That the Cabinet Member for Finance and Cabinet Member for Property, Highways and Transport agreed to the following capital release request of £431,607 from the Disabled Facilities Grant Major Adaptations to Property 2023/24 programme budget (Appendix A).
Reason for decision	The amount of grant funding requested has been established by taking the number of cases currently in the development stage and application stage of the process. Each case has been estimated at an average cost of £8k and £45k for extensions. This gives an overall figure of £671,000. The current amount left from DFG release 1 is £311,327.14, which, when deducted, gives us a total of £359,672.86. With contingency and fees, this totals £431,607 to complete major adaptation cases. This enables officers' control over service delivery and major adaptation works can be completed within the timescales required.
