Decision	Approved
	That the Leader of the Council and the Cabinet Member for Property, Highways and Transport agreed with the rent negotiated by officers as detailed in the report and instructed Property and Estates to complete the appropriate rent review memorandum.
Reason for decision	Lengthy negotiations have taken place with the tenant and a substantial rental increase has been agreed in principle, resulting in an income increase for the General Fund. This increase, showing a 13% uplift, is particularly positive in the current difficult property climate, after the backdrop of lockdown period and its peripheral effects. Officers are confident that this is the maximum achievable rental increase for this rent review.
Alternative options	The alternative is not to approve the agreed-in-principle rental
considered and rejected	increase for this rent review. This is likely to lead to the rent review being referred for third party determination by arbitration.
