Reason for decision	These decisions allow for the release of capital funding for the final phase of construction of the new the Platinum Jubilee Leisure Centre in West Drayton. The decisions enable the continued client-management for the remaining works to completion, to be supported by expert consultants and project-led by the Interim Corporate Director of Place. Remaining works include the external fabric, mechanical and electrical works, fit-out and finishes up to practical completion.
Alternative options considered and rejected	Not to proceed with the use of the funds would delay the project completion further and cause damage to the existing structure. This could result in additional costs in rectifying damage and additional inflationary costs.
