Based on the responses received to the formal consultation, arranged for the implementation of the Parking Management Scheme in Redmead Road, Hayes as proposed as new 'Zone HY7' with the operating hours of '9am-10pm everyday' at the earliest opportunity; and</li> </ul>

Prior to implementation of the Parking Management Scheme 'Zone HY7' in Redmead Road, Hayes, asked officers to conduct formal consultation on proposed amendments, to change the shared use bay operational '9am to 10pm everyday', to pay and display bays operational 'Monday to Saturday 8am to 6:30pm'.
