	1) Accept the grant award of £107,183.91 from the Lawn Tennis Association (LTA) Parks Tennis Renovation Grant for the upgrade of tennis courts at Moorhall Recreation Ground, noting this will also be reported to Cabinet.
	2) Approve the direct award appointment of Aggregate Industries UK Ltd T/A Spadeoak via the LTA Framework 'Framework for a Parks Improvement Programme' via Lot 1- Southwest London and Southeast to upgrade the tennis courts at Moorhall Recreation Ground, Harefield over a 6-week period from 26th June 2024 to 20th August 2024 at the value of £107,183.91.
	3) Agree to the capital release request of £107,183.91 for the upgrade of tennis courts at Moorhall Recreation Ground. (Appendix A)
